Hosted by Navttcofficial, the session brought together international and national delegates to discuss strategies for improving workforce readiness and fostering collaboration between employers and TVET institutions.

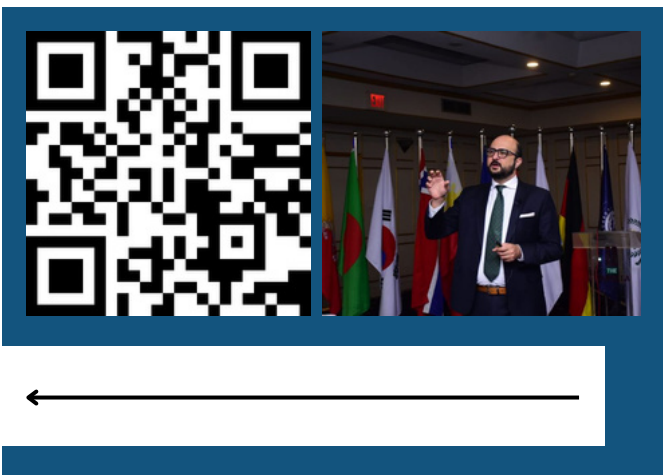


UPDATE ON INTERNATIONAL BUS TERMINAL PROJECT

ISLAMABAD - On the morning of July 17th, 2024, the tech world woke up to chaos. What started as a routine update from CrowdStrike, one of the biggest names in cybersecurity, quickly spiraled into a significant Windows outage. The ripple effects of this incident were felt across the globe, affecting millions of users and businesses. CrowdStrike, renowned for its cutting-edge endpoint detection and response (EDR) and extended detection and response (XDR) solutions, had made a grave error. They sent out an update without proper patch testing, a technical blunder that exposed the vulnerabilities in their processes. This untested update made
